Subject: **Input required for July 2018 NPA 236/250/604/778, 289/365/905, 343/613, 403/587/780/825, 450/579, 506 and 709 Relief Planning Numbering Resource Utilization Forecast (R-NRUF)**

On 31 May 2016 the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC) released four Telecom Notices of Consultation:

- CRTC 2016-205, *Establishment of a CISC ad hoc committee for relief planning for area code 709 in Newfoundland and Labrador;*
- CRTC 2016-206, *Establishment of a CISC ad hoc committee for relief planning for area code 506 in New Brunswick;*
- CRTC 2016-207, *Establishment of a CISC ad hoc committee for relief planning for area codes 418 and 581 in eastern Quebec; and,*
- CRTC 2016-208, *Establishment of a CISC ad hoc committee for relief planning for area codes 236, 250, 604 and 778 in British Columbia.*

On 20 March 2018 the Canadian Numbering Administrator (CNA) released 2018 G-NRUF results that indicated that NPAs 289/365/905, 306/639, 343/613, 403/587/780/825 and 450/579 had entered the relief planning window of 72 months. NPA 236/250/604/778, NPA 418/581, NPA 506 and NPA 709 have already been in relief planning for the past year or more. The CNA has already collected NPA 306/639 R-NRUF data for June 2018 and on 12 June 2018 the Canadian Steering Committee on Numbering agreed that the CNA should not collect NPA 418/581 R-NRUF data as the new Overlay NPA will be in-service on 24 November 2018. Accordingly, R-NRUF data for NPAs 306/639 and 418/581 are not included in this request.

In accordance with the *Canadian Numbering Resource Utilization Forecast (C-NRUF) Guideline* (the Guideline), approved by the Commission in Telecom Decision CRTC 2015-166 dated 29 April 2015, the CNA is requesting July 2018 **R-NRUF** inputs for NPAs 236/250/604/778, 289/365/905, 343/613, 403/587/780/825, 450/579, 506 and 709. The July 2018 R-NRUF data will due by **7 August 2018**.

In accordance with the Guideline, all current and prospective CO Code Holders are required to provide forecast CO Code requirements at the Exchange Area level of detail once an NPA has entered the timeframe for NPA Relief Planning.

The CNA is providing the attached R-NRUF worksheets for completion by current and prospective CO Code Holders in NPA 236/250/604/778, NPA 289/365/905, NPA 343/613 NPA 403/587/780/825, NPA 450/579, NPA 506 and NPA 709. Current and prospective CO Code Holders are required to provide the total quantity of assigned and reserved CO Codes assigned to them as of 1 January 2018 and 1 July 2018, and a forecast of the total cumulative quantity of existing and future CO Codes forecast to be assigned and reserved as of the first day of each year from 2019 up to and including 2024. These forms must be completed and submitted to the nruf@cnac.ca e-mail address of the CNA, no later than **7 August 2018**.

All CO Code Holder inputs will be treated as confidential in accordance with the Guideline. Aggregate July 2018 R-NRUF results will be posted on the CNA website at: http://www.cnac.ca/co_codes/nruf/latest_forms/nruf_latest_forms.htm#Results once the information has been consolidated.
