To: **Current and Prospective Canadian Central Office (CO) Code Holders in NPA 306/639**

Subject: **Input required for NPA 306/639 May 2018 Relief Planning Numbering Resource Utilization Forecast (R-NRUF)**

On 20 March 2018 the Canadian Numbering Administrator (CNA) released 2018 G-NRUF results which indicated that NPA 306/639 had entered the relief planning window and the Projected Exhaust date (PED) had advanced by 29 months to June 2022 from the July 2017 R-NRUF result of November 2024.

In accordance with the Guideline, all current and prospective CO Code Holders are required to provide a forecast of CO Code requirements at the Exchange Area level of detail once an NPA has entered the timeframe for NPA Relief Planning. Since the NPA 306/639 PED has advanced so significantly to June 2022, the CNA is providing the attached R-NRUF form for completion by current and prospective CO Code Holders in NPA 306/639 prior to the normal mid-year R-NRUF request.

Current and prospective CO Code Holders are required to provide the total quantity of assigned and reserved CO Codes assigned to them as of 1 January 2018 and 1 May 2018, and a forecast of the total cumulative quantity of existing and future CO Codes forecast to be assigned and reserved as of the first day of each year from 2019 up to and including 2024. These forms must be completed and submitted to the nruf@cnac.ca e-mail address of the CNA, no later than **10 June 2018**.

All CO Code Holder inputs will be treated as confidential in accordance with the Guideline. Aggregate May 2018 R-NRUF results will be posted on the CNA website at:
