The Canadian Steering Committee on Numbering (CSCN) is currently working on a report for Task Information Form (TIF) 110 - *"Identify Solutions to Mitigate NPA and NXX Numbering Exhaust"*, which was requested in a letter from CRTC staff to the CSCN Chair on 19 January 2022.

The committee has been dedicated to producing a worthwhile and meaningful report and has therefore committed to weekly 3-hour conference calls to review and assemble the report content. While the committee trusts that CRTC staff will find the report useful when further studying NPA and NXX numbering exhaust, the committee believes that it will be able to produce a more comprehensive report if the committee works beyond the original report due date of 18 May 2022.

The CSCN intends to complete a TIF 110 final consensus report by 30 June 2022.
